

# GIFT WRAPPING RULES AND PROCEDURES

## Gift Wrap 2005 - Troop 209

### GROUND RULES

We have three primary objectives: Money, Money, and More Money.

We have five Secondary objectives:

- A. Do a professional job, in a professional manner
- B. Present Troop 209 in a positive way to the public
- C. Have a Good Time.
- D. GET ASKED BACK FOR 2006
- E. Did I mention MONEY?

**To accomplish these goals, the following guidelines will be observed.**

1. NO SHIFT SWAPPING OR CHANGING WITHOUT NOTIFICATION AND APPROVAL FROM BRAD RECKER OR HIS DESIGNEE.

2. ONE PARENT for each Scout

Exceptions:

- A. A parent with two boys (cannot be the only boys on shift).
- C. An ADULT relative may substitute for a parent.
- D. An Eagle brother may substitute for a parent with parent's permission.
- E. If Brad Recker approves something different IN ADVANCE.

3. NO SIBLINGS (sorry, there's just no room unless arrangements have been made in advance with Brad Recker)

4. BE AT YOUR SHIFT **EARLY** (not just on time); CLEAN, IN **FULL** UNIFORM, FED, WATERED, RESTED, HAVING GONE TO THE BATHROOM, IN A POSITIVE FRAME OF MIND, IN GOOD HEALTH, AND READY TO GO TO WORK, OR DON'T COME AT ALL. (See Rule Number 1)

5. WHEN YOUR **SCHEDULED** SHIFT IS OVER, IT'S OVER, PLEASE LEAVE, UNLESS YOU ARE ASKED TO STAY **BY THE ADULT IN CHARGE**. IF YOU ARE LATE, (see rules 1 & 4) DON'T **EXPECT** TO STAY LATER "TO GET YOUR HOURS IN". YOU WILL BE CREDITED FOR THE SCHEDULED HOURS THAT **YOU ARE THERE**. You will be welcome to stay if there is a backlog to be caught up and credited with that time.

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6. RE: Rule 5...DON'T SIGN UP FOR THE LAST SHIFT OF THE DAY UNLESS YOU ARE PREPARED TO STAY UNTIL THEY KICK US OUT OR THE NIGHT'S WORK IS DONE. You WILL be credited for any overtime work.

7. SIGN IN AND SIGN OUT IF YOU WANT TO GET PAID. It's **NOT** a good idea to depend on Brad Recker's memory, two or three days later.

8. AT LEAST ONE BOY (The younger, smaller boys are typically the most effective) PUSHES MISTLETOE, OUT IN FRONT, ALL THE TIME, UNLESS ALL HANDS, including the parents, ARE WRAPPING. Parents **are** expected to work the front desk and lend a hand, wrapping, when it gets busy.

9. NO BOYS ARE TO WORK THE FRONT DESK, TAKING IN GIFTS AND HANDING OUT WRAPPED PACKAGES, UNLESS SPECIFICALLY OKAYED BY BRAD RECKER AND BACKED UP BY A PARENT'S CREDIT CARD AND DELIVERY SERVICES.

In other words, if **you** want **your boy** on the front desk, be prepared to fix any mistakes he may make. This may mean replacing a missing gift or delivering and picking up gifts he has not given to the correct people. Clifford Renfro and Jon Downam are the **ONLY** boys ever to work the front desk and JR and Jack **EXPECTED** to be held responsible for their performance. **BE FOREWARNED**, Trust is a wonderful thing but it may cost YOU Time, Money, and Gasoline.

10. PLEASE DON'T MESS WITH OUR SYSTEM!!! IT WORKS PERFECTLY! IF YOU THINK YOU'VE GOT A BETTER IDEA, TELL BRAD RECKER, BUT EXPECT TO PROOF IT OUT BEFORE GENERAL ADOPTION.

11. PLEASE DON'T SMELL BAD AND LEADERS PLEASE BE IN UNIFORM WHEN AT ALL POSSIBLE.

We are working in a 10' by 12' enclosed area. If you can smell yourself, **BELIEVE ME**, we can too. Sometimes we can when you can't. J.R. says, "Please, make any mistakes on the sweet side."
